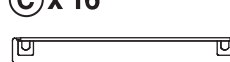

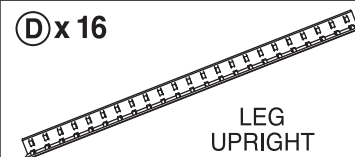

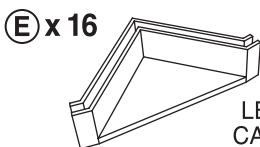

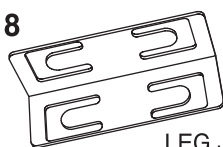

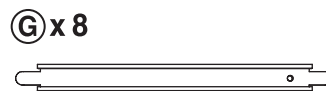

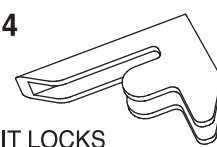

SAFETY:



- Read these instructions carefully and thoroughly. Keep these instructions.
- During assembly, keep small parts out of reach of children.
- Keep packaging and plastic bags away from children for fear of suffocation.
- When unpacking the product, take out all parts and place on top of the carton or another clean surface.
- Before assembly, compare all the unassembled parts with the 'List of Parts' diagram above, making sure all parts are present.
- Clear the work area of any potential hazards before commencing work and the assembly process.
- Before use, make sure this product is assembled as shown in the instructions.

WARNING:



- Always wear gloves when assembling the unit to prevent injury.
- Never exceed the maximum shelf load of 100kg.
- Load smaller stable items on the top shelf, heavier and bulkier items should be stored on the bottom shelf.
- Loads on shelves must be evenly distributed so that no harm is done to the wooden shelves.
- This product is not suitable for rooms with elevated humidity, as this could cause damage to the wooden shelves.
- Spilled liquids can damage the wooden shelves. Replace shelves if this happens.
- When assembling, keep this product away from electric conduits.
- Only erect this product on horizontal, smooth floors, or stability and maximum load-bearing capacity cannot be guaranteed.
- Always use a rubber mallet lightly during assembly to avoid damaging this product.
- Never allow children or adults to climb or hang on this product.
- For your safety, the shelf unit(s) must always be assembled with a suitable wall mounting (sold separately).
- Please only use wall plugs and retaining screws which are suitable for your type of wall and the weight of the unit.

HINT:

- If connector tabs of the shelf cross pieces bend on assembly, they can be bent back gently into their original position with the aid of a flat head screwdriver.

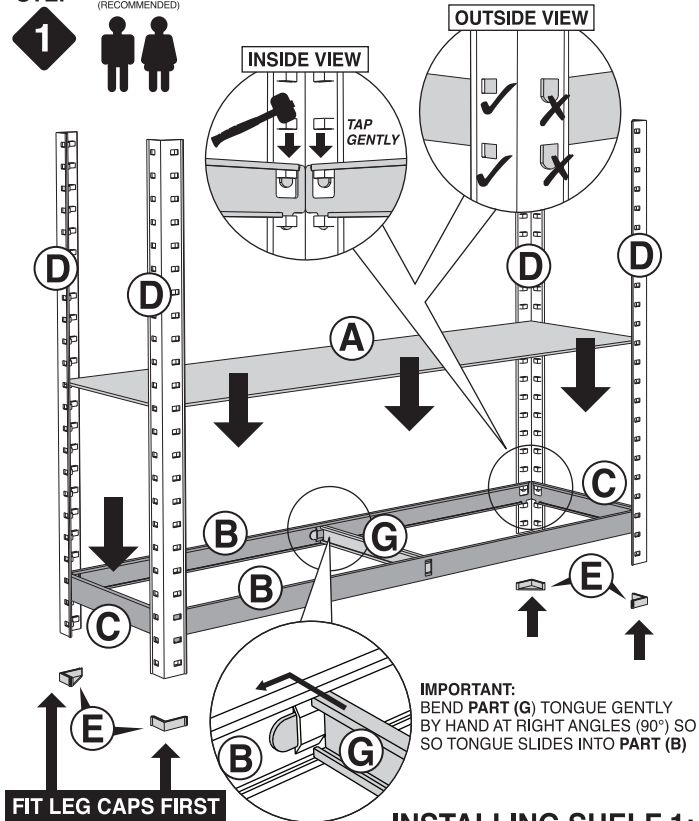

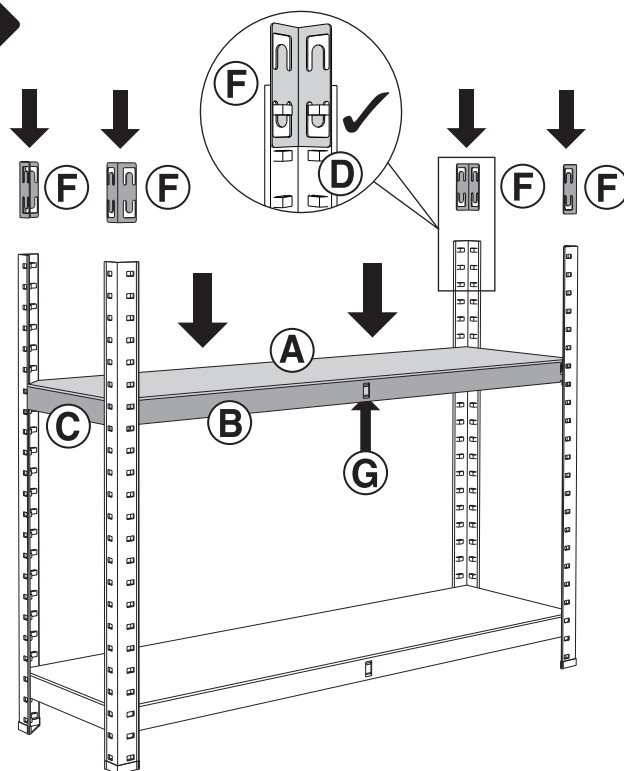

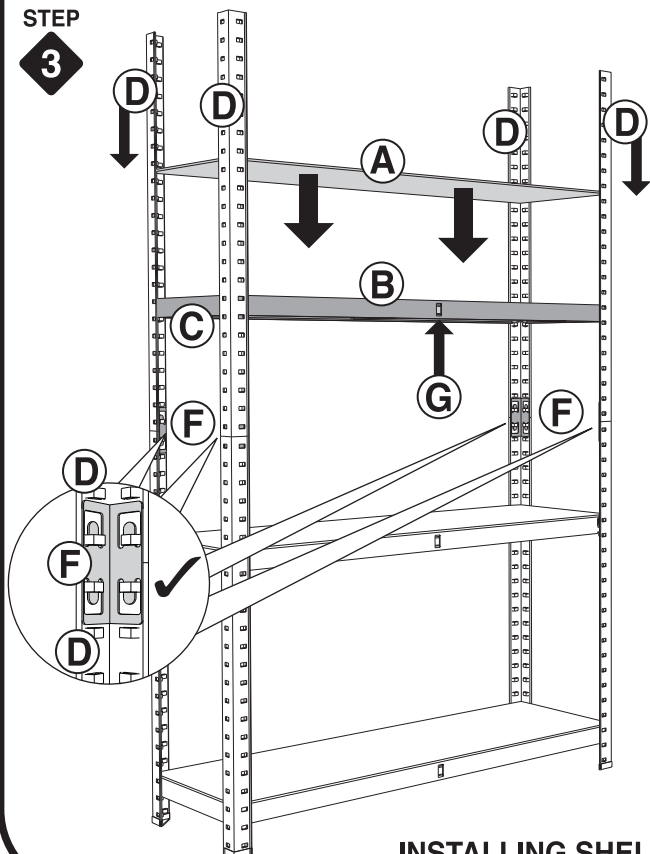
INSTALLING SHELF 1:

STEP 2



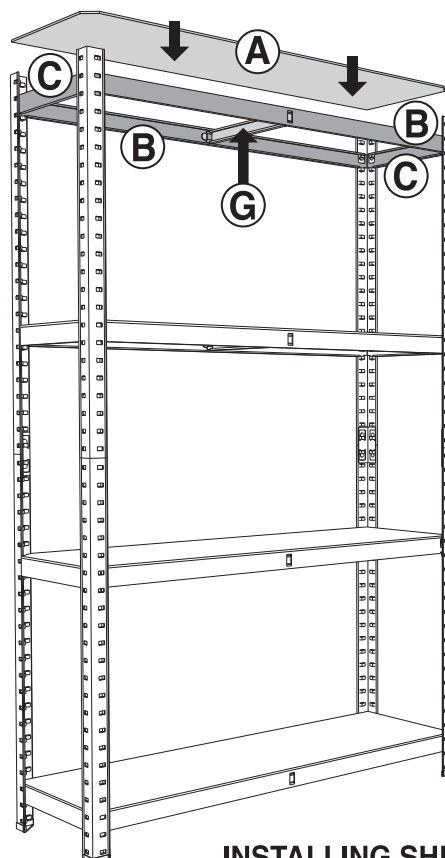
INSTALLING SHELF 2:

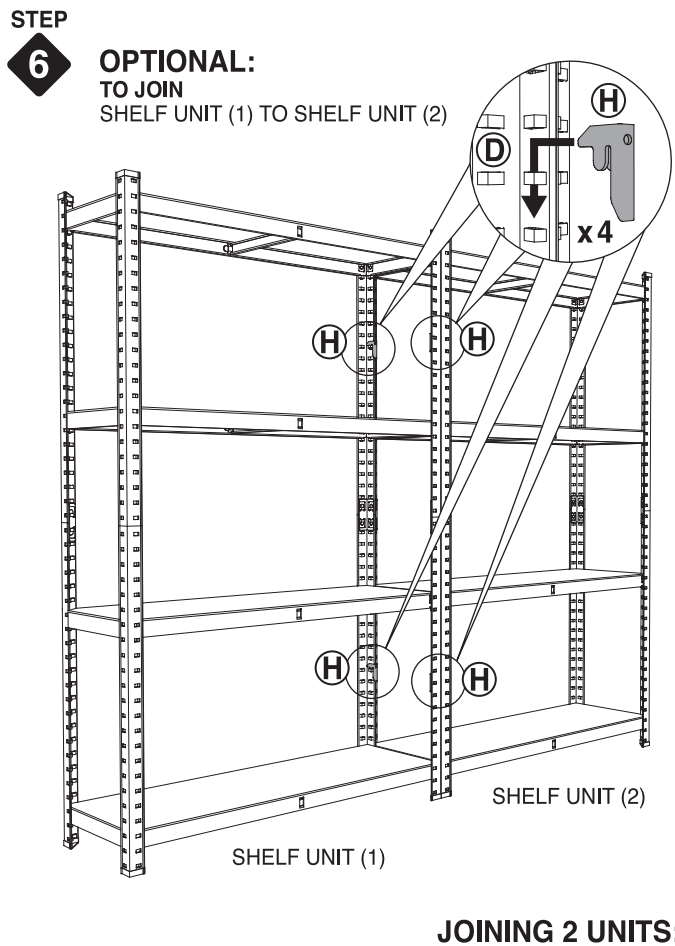
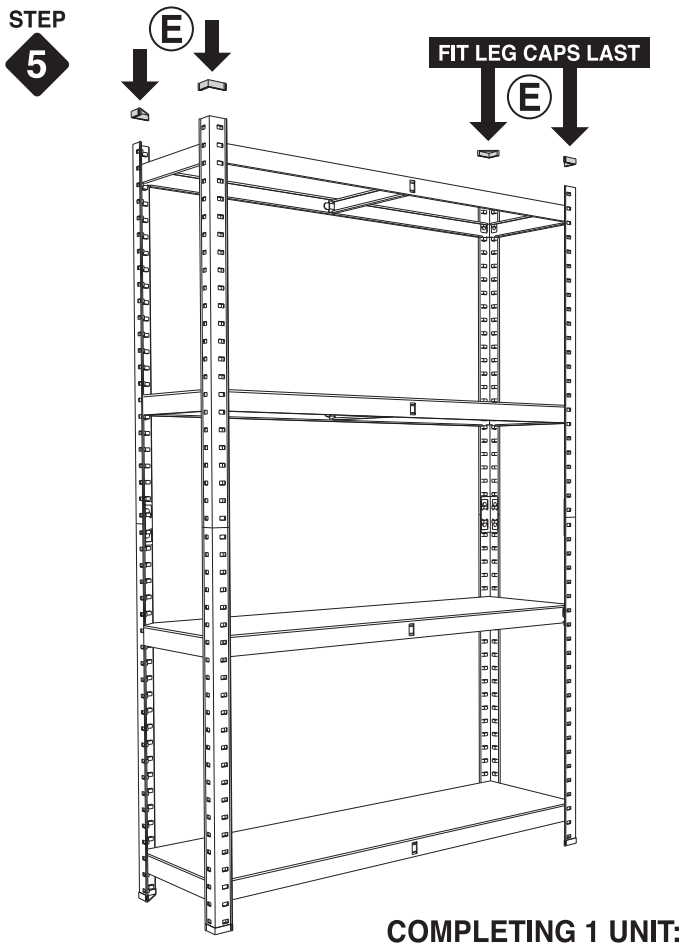

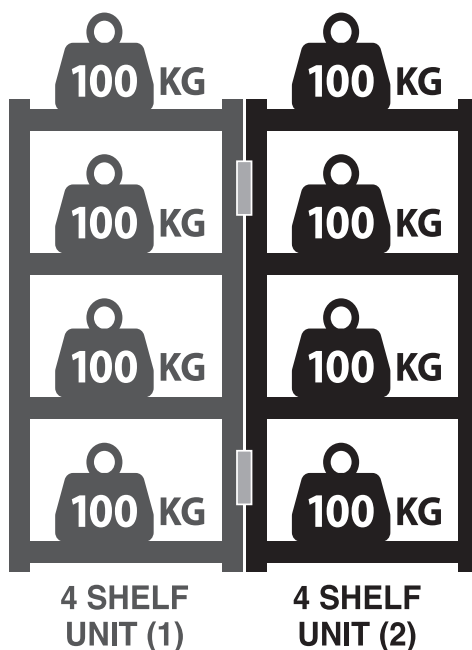
